



INTRODUCTION

In the year 1942, British Government established a Federally controlled Anti Corruption Department in India with the name of Special Police Establishment to fight against the menace of Corruption which was rampant in supplies and procurements. After independence, this department was renamed as Pakistan Special Police Establishment (PSPE).


In the year 1975, in the light of the report of Mr. G. Ahmad committee on "Police Reforms", PSPE was replaced with Federal Investigation Agency (FIA) by promulgating the FIA Act, 1974 (Act-VIII of 1975). Besides the role of an anti corruption agency, FIA was assigned a number of other assignments including immigration control at all the notified international entry / exit check points.

FIA has now gained the role of a prime national investigation agency which is fighting against organized crimes in Pakistan. FIA is investigating the cases related to bribery / Corruption, Cyber crimes, Economic crimes, Trafficking in Person, Human Smuggling, Money Laundering, Violation of Intellectual Property rights, Spurious Drugs, Counterfeit Currency, Electricity/Gas/ Oil theft, Illegal organ transplant, Hawala and Terrorism.

FIA is headed by a BS 21/22 officer of Police Service of Pakistan. Its headquarter is situated in sector G-9/4 at Islamabad. Five Additional Director Generals BS-21 assist DG/FIA in supervising the working of the agency at headquarters whereas three ADGs i.e. ADG/North, ADG/South and ADG/CCW conduct the overall supervision of the field operations through seven zonal Directors and one Director Operations (CCW). Its total sanctioned strength is 6402.

FIA is running its operational functions through in 29 cities / Towns with 52 notified police stations. These offices are located in Islamabad, all provincial headquarters, prominent big cities and immigration posts at international border.

The Administration wing consists of Establishment, Accounts, Logistic, Security, Estate & Development, and performance & Internal Accountability Branch (PIAB). Each Branch / Section is supervised by Additional Director/Deputy Director.

IMMIGRATION WING

The Immigration Wing is headed by an Additional Director General (BS-21) who assists the Director General and coordinates with the zonal Directors. Immigration wing has three Directorates namely Immigration, Anti Human Smuggling and Integrated Border Management System (IBMS).

Immigration Directorate

The Immigration Directorate regulates the flow of international passengers and prevents instances of human smuggling, enforces ECL and BL, issuance of tourist and business visas on arrival through its 25 regulated entry / exit points which include 13 Airports, 06 Land Routes, 04 Seaports and 02 Railway Stations.

Anti Human Smuggling Directorate

Anti Human Trafficking circles deal with matters pertaining to prevention, investigation and prosecution of crimes related to human smuggling and trafficking. AHTC Circles are involved in the identification of the victims and sending them to shelter homes, prosecuting the culprits, building a database of human traffickers, compilation of Red Book and liaising with NGOs, provincial police and international agencies / partners. Moreover, the Directorate through its International offices in Oman, Iran and Greece has successfully countered the human smuggling issues.

INTEGRATED BORDER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (IBMS)

Integrated Border Management System (IBMS) Directorate maintains the data of movement of travelers across the borders. Data of more than 142.5 million travelers has been entered in IBMS database. IBMS is providing complete technical support at all entry / exit points / check posts. IBMS data has been quite useful in analyzing the details of frequent travelers involved in currency smuggling and initiating the investigation accordingly.

IBMS is providing support to its different stakeholders (i.e. All Law Enforcement Agencies - LEAs, Investigation Agencies - IAs and various day to day tasks assigned by Ministry of Interior and Apex Courts.)

Performance and Achievements of IBMS

- Total **8,532,325** travelers have been recorded in IBMS system. **4,490,677** travelers have arrived in Pakistan out of which 3,034,696 are Pakistani Nationals and 1,455,981 are Foreigners. 4,041,658 travelers have departed from Pakistan. Out of which **2,648,337** are Pakistani Nationals and **1,393,321** are Foreigners.
- **1,082** Hit Cases were intercepted at different IBMS sites on the basis of Stop list.
- IBMS System has entertained 24,107 queries received from government departments. LEAs and Intelligence Agencies regarding provision of traveler's record.
- Placement of persons on Interpol / ECL / Black List (Visa & Passport), subsequent updating of records is sole discretion / authority of Ministry of Interior and Directorate General I&P. In this regard, 100,552 entries of Interpol / ECL / Black List were updated in IBMS during the above mentioned period.
- **13,602** off-loadees and **41,309** deportees were also recorded in IBMS.
- **5,917** C-Form were issued to foreigner travelers from different IBMS sites.

ANTI-CORRUPTION WING

Anti-Corruption Wing (ACW) is headed by an Additional Director General (BS-21) who assists the Director General FIA in matters related to anti-corruption. ADG ACW is assisted by a Director and three Deputy Directors at the HQ. There are 14 ACW circles in Pakistan which are working under the administrative control of two Additional Director Generals i.e ADG North & ADG South Regions.

ACW work actively against officers in public departments who are found misusing and abusing their official position for wrongful gains. It mainly deals with the cases of corruption involving federal departments and act as a safeguard against losses to federal exchequer. In addition, it also deals with cases involving spurious drugs, counterfeit currencies, Special Laws as well as crimes falling under PPC.

CENTRAL CRIME RECORD OFFICE (CCRO)

ECONOMIC CRIME WING

Economic Crime Wing (ECW) is headed by an Additional Director General BS-21 who is assisted by Director and a Deputy Director. It augments the efforts of FIA Zonal Directorates against the money laundering by providing policy frame work. It issues guidelines for the EOs / IOs, makes arrangements for capacity building, identifies lacunas in investigational work and removes barriers at implementation level. ECW also coordinates with FMU in connection with the STRs and related AML initiatives / proceedings. Moreover, ECW collects and analyses data on economic crimes.

CYBER CRIME WING (CCW)

Cyber Crime Wing, formerly known as National Response Centre for Cyber Crime (NR3C), has been added to FIA's mandate to deal with growing complaints of cyber crimes. It has specialized units which investigate complaints received from individuals, corporate sector and government department relating to cyber crimes. It also safeguards cyber space against any misuse or abuse. Cyber Crime wing is headed by an Additional Director General who is assisted by Director Operations along with a number of Additional Directors.

Cyber Crime has taken many initiatives to educate the nation about seriousness of Cyber crimes. It issues advisory Notes and alert messages against cyber threats through social media. Cyber Rescue 1991 is also providing 24/7 services to help the victims of Cyber Crime.

NATIONAL CENTRAL BUREAU-INTERPOL (NCB)

Pakistan became member of ICPC (International Criminal Police Commission) in 1952. The National Central Bureau (NCB) of Pakistan was created under the new constitution of ICPO in 1957. It has been attached with Federal Investigation Agency since its inception. The Director General/FIA is ex- officio, the Head of NCB-Pakistan. In 1990 the Secretariat General (SG) of ICPO - Interpol Lyon introduced new Communication System namely X-400 to exchange mails electronically amongst all Interpol member states. NCB-Pakistan was connected with X-400 system in 1999. Interpol SG Lyon replaced X-400 System in 2002 with a new Web based Communication System namely 1/24-7. In May 2004, Interpol SG Lyon has provided the equipment for the system free of cost. During 2005, Interpol SG Lyon has also provided equipment for the extension of I-24/7.

Performance & Achievements of NCB

Interpol Notices of Pakistani National Origin

During the period under report, 147 Interpol Notices were issued by Secretariat General of ICPO-Interpol Lyon France on the request of NCB Islamabad.

Extradition

58 Pak Nationals were got extradited from different countries including Greece, UAE, Indonesia, Muscat, USA, Sharjah, Qatar, Oman, Bahrain, Trinidad and Tabaggo.

Deportation

79 Pak Nationals, including 13 from Ireland, 09 from Germany and 57 from Greece respectively, were got deported from different countries

Interception

01 Pak National was Intercepted from Dubai on 20.06.2020.

Messages and Letters

During the year, 11154 messages/letters were received from member states as well as local authorities whereas 12211 messages / letters were dispatched to local authorities and Interpol member states.

COUNTER TERRORISM WING (CTW)

In 2003, Federal Government assigned a limited Counter Terrorism role to FIA and a set up with the name of Special Investigation Group (SIG) was established in FIA. SIG Officers were provided extensive trainings in the area of crime scene analysis, computer forensic analysis / cyber terrorism, terrorist financing investigations and post blast explosives analysis etc. under Anti-Terrorism Assistance Program. Necessary equipment was provided by US Govt. Later on, the nomenclature of SIG was changed as Counter Terrorism Wing (CTW).

CTW is now headed by a Director (BPS-20) who reports directly to DG FIA and exercises same powers and authority as of a Zonal Director. FIA Headquarter provides the budget, strength and logistic support to CTW. CTW has mandated to conduct enquiry and investigation in offences relating to Terrorism, Terrorist Financing and Cyber Terrorism. CTW also conducts explosives analysis and digital forensic analysis etc.

Software Application/Databases

CTW has designed and developed customized web-based applications, description of which is as under:-

- National Criminal Database (NCDB) has been developed.
- Details of 55882 accused / suspected terrorists have been entered.
- 12068 terrorist incidents have been entered.
- CTW Archives have been set up for the quick search and retrieval of CTW documents, presentations, crime scene reports, intelligence and interrogation reports, briefs, explosive and forensics reports etc.

National Criminal Database (NCDB)

Dfuze Intelligence Management system was established in CTW Wing in 2008 with the assistance of UK Govt. This system is capable of storing data about Explosives, IEDs, Incidents, Terrorists and Terrorists Organizations etc. Recently CTW has extended the connectivity of Dfuze to provincial CIDs / CTDs with the assistance of UK & Australian Govts. This system has been renamed as National Criminal Database (NCDB). All the data which was previously stored in TIS and TIA has now been transferred to NCDB, whereas fresh data is directly being entered into it by CTW/FIA and provincial CIDs/CTD.

Technical Wing was set up in early 1975. Since its inception, the wing has been providing scientific and forensic assistance to various units of the FIA, NAB, Islamabad Police, Azad Kashmir Police, Railway Police, Federal Government departments, Banks, Financial Institutions, Pakistan Armed Forces and Provincial Police departments (on special request).

Functions

There are three operational sections of the Wing;

- Questioned Documents Section.
- Fingerprint Section.
- Chemical Analysis Section.

First two sections examine the disputed signatures, writings, alterations, additions, erasing, substitutions, rubber seal impressions, finger prints and obliteration of engraved number of stolen vehicles and weapons.

Chemical Analysis section examines the engine and chassis numbers of suspected vehicles, weapons and also identifies the cuts and welding of metallic sheets and plates etc.
