## **Visa**

1. Indian visa is city specific with fixed entry/exit points. Places of intended visit and hotel location should correspond to cities mentioned in the visa.
2. Visa for all the cities intended to be visited should be obtained prior to arrival.
3. Our citizen can only enter India from Mumbai, Delhi & Chennai (By Air), Wagha/Attari (by train, bus or on foot), Khokhrapar/Munabao (by train) and Mumbai (by sea).
4. When in India, always carry passport having valid visa with you.

## **Police Reporting**

5. Unless visa mentions "Police Reporting Exempted", please report to area police station or designated office within 24 hours of arrival and 24 hours prior to departure.
6. As per visa agreement signed in 2012, Senior Citizen (more than 65 years of age) and children (below 12 years) are exempt from Police Reporting.

## **Mobile Connections**

7. As of now, no Pakistani mobile operator has roaming service in India. Indian SIMs can be

purchased at the Airports by presenting copies of passport with valid visa and photo (Please carry copies of your passports and photo).

#### **Import Regulations**

8. Foreigners cannot carry any amount of Indian currency into India. Foreign currency equal to US\$5000/- and another US\$5000/- in the form of instruments such as pay order, travelers cheques is permissible on arrival/departure. Any amount higher than the above has to be declared.
9. Importing more than 200 cigarettes is not allowed. (Smoking at public places is prohibited in India. In sikh majority areas, smoking is considered an offence).

#### **Other Important Information**

11. Taxis can be hired from airports, on telephone and from taxi stands. Please insist on meter fares.
12. Effective March, 2014, Polio Vaccination Certificate is mandatory to enter India.
